



SNOW DAY HOME LEARNING MENU

LITERACY

- Read a snowy story. Find one online.
- Write your own snow story. Read it to your family or record a video.
- Make a word search using winter words.
- Practice sounds and spellings in the snow.
- Read for pleasure.

MATHEMATICS

- Practice writing times tables and number facts in the snow.
- Bring a bowl of snow inside and time how long it takes to melt.
- Make as many 2D & 3D shapes as you can using the snow.
- Sort objects from around the house using size/colour.

SCIENCE & TECH

- Create an ice bowl – Fill a bowl with water. Add items that float and sink. Add reflective & bright materials. Freeze in the freezer or outside.
- Record how your ice bowl looks. (photograph, drawing, picture, collage)

EXPRESSIVE ARTS

- Create a sculpture. Use snow or junk items from your house.
- Record your sculpture by drawing a picture or taking a photo.
- Drawing the view from your window.
- Learn a dance routine by following a video online.

HUMANITIES

- Look at a map of the country and record weather.
- Find temperature differences of countries across the world.
- Find out information about record breaking weather.
- Research historical expeditions e.g. Shackleton's Journey.

WELLBEING

- Make a snow angel.
- Practice long jumps in the snow. Try to beat your previous distance.
- Time how many snow balls you can make in 2 minutes.
- Do a yoga video or workout online.
